

Milwee Middle School Solo and Ensemble Information DUE TUESDAY, JANUARY 9th, 2024


This year's solo and ensemble event will be held at Milwee Middle School on March 1st & 2nd, 2024.

Students will prepare a solo and/or ensemble to perform for a judge (adjudicator.) Each adjudicator uses an evaluation form, which is made available to the director and students who participate. Ratings range from I (Superior) to V (Poor). Students who achieve a Superior rating receive a medal to wear on their uniform. This is a great opportunity for students to challenge themselves outside of the classroom, and receive feedback and praise for their individual (small group) achievements. Please understand that students who sign up are expected to perform at the event. Please do not sign up if you do not plan on practicing and being prepared for this event.

Students performing a solo are required to have a piano accompanist. He/she will rehearse with students at Milwee 1-2 times before the performance and will perform with them at the event. (Rehearsal times/days will vary. Students will be given advance notice of when their pianist will be coming.) Students are responsible for paying the one time accompanist fee of \$40 at THE FIRST scheduled rehearsal.
